

### APPLICATION FOR A CRANE PERMIT

BS 7121 Pt1 Para 9.3.3. requires that “*The appointed person should consult the Aerodrome/Airfield Manager for permission to work if a crane is to be used within 6km of the Aerodrome/Airfield and its height exceeds 10 metres above ground level or the level of surrounding structures or trees*”. Piling rigs and other similar tall devices come under this heading and process).

This permission should be sought at least one month prior to the use of the crane in order to consider the impact on aviation activities and to allow consultation with outside agencies if necessary.

An application to Blackpool Airport for a Crane Permit should be made via email to [bia\\_atc@blackpoolairport.com](mailto:bia_atc@blackpoolairport.com) and [safeguarding@blackpoolairport.com](mailto:safeguarding@blackpoolairport.com).

The following information will be required:

- Dates of crane operation (it is best to over-estimate the end date and advise us if finished early rather than have the Permit time expire before the job is complete),

- Nature of the project (building, piling, moving materials from one location to another),

- Geographical location (street names and lat/long coordinates as accurately as possible),

- Height of ground level at that location above mean sea level (info derived from Google Earth is sufficient),

- Maximum height of extended jib or device above ground level – note that this is not maximum jib extension as it is unlikely to be used fully extended vertically,

- Hours of operation each day, and whether the jib is to be lowered/stowed at night or remain raised (a red light will be required at the top if the jib remains raised overnight),

- Local contact number should it become necessary to lower the jib in case of emergency.

It is necessary for the Airport to charge for this service. Fees are detailed on the Airport website ([www.blackpoolairport.com](http://www.blackpoolairport.com)).
