To oversee the planning, scheduling, and execution of airfield maintenance activities to ensure that the airports infrastructure, equipment, and facilities meet the required standards and operational needs of the airport.

Responsibilities / Tasks:

Operational

- Source and appoint specialist contractors where required.
- Oversee and manage external contractors in accordance with the airport Control Of Contractors Procedures.
- Ensure testing, Maintenance, repair and installation of all electrical facilities is undertaken by approved contractors.
- Identify faults, carry out general maintenance activities
- Report defects, keep records and logs of equipment maintenance.
- Comply with all Health and Safety Regulations, inform the relevant department and personnel of unsafe equipment, practices or deficiencies.
- Airfield maintenance, installation of signs, line painting, pavement repairs and general airfield maintenance duties.

Safety

- Operate within prescribed Safe Systems of Work.
- Knowledge and understanding of all appropriate safety responsibilities as detailed in the SMS and Aerodrome Manual.
- To carry out duties in a manner which minimises the incidents and accidents within your Department, particularly promoting a safe working environment.
- To advise your Manager of any safety occurrence or system failure and to identify and report any situation of potential risk or concern affecting safety of which they are aware.

• To report any safety occurrence or system failure and to identify and report any situation of potential risk or concern affecting safety of which they are aware.

Security

- To ensure knowledge and understanding of all appropriate security responsibilities as detailed in job description and other relevant policy documents.
- To ensure that standards set at security training courses are adhered to.
